Scholarship Rules

Charity Lodge No. 27 will award scholarships each year; the number of scholarships and the amount of each will be determined by the members of the Lodge Scholarship Committee.

Eligibility: Students must have a 2.5 or better GPA (4 point system) during their Junior and Senior years. Students must have an acceptable attendance record during those years. A letter from the high school guidance counselor stating both GPA and attendance must be attached. Students must submit a letter/essay, of at least 500 words, discussing their accomplishments both in school and in their community, their leadership qualities, their service to others, and their patriotism.

The Award: The scholarship grants will not exceed \$1000.00 each. Payment will be made to the university or college of the student's choice. If the student decides not to attend college, the monies will be returned to Charity Lodge No. 27. The scholarships are open to the public, but preference will be given to children or grandchildren of members of Charity Lodge No. 27, if they are qualified.
