## THE TIMOTHY G. HORSEY MEMORIAL AWARD

The Timothy G. Horsey Memorial Award has been established by Mr. and Mrs. David G. Horsey and Sons of Laurel in memory of their son, Timothy G. Horsey, a 1983 graduate of Laurel High School.

Each year, two \$1,000 awards will be given to graduating seniors from Laurel High School who wish to pursue a career in a trade area, and who plan to immediately enter the workplace, or who plan to attend a vocational or technical training program leading to a certificate or an Associates or Bachelors Degree in a vocation or technical field.

## Criteria for the award are as follows:

- Demonstrated aptitude in a vocational or technical field, as documented by recommendation and/or employer recommendation.
- A "B" or better grade in related field.
- Respect for peers and adults in school, community, and if applicable, a work setting.
- Demonstrated work ethic.
- Good school citizenship.
- Evidence of good work habits, i.e.; excellent school attendance, on-time to school and to class, dependability, reliability, willingness to learn from mistakes.

Interested students must file an application provided by the Guidance department at Laurel High School. The scholarship committee will forward the top four to six candidates to the Horsey Family, who will conduct interviews with the top candidates.

Recipients will be notified through the Guidance department of their selection. The award will be paid directly to the school toward tuition for those students pursuing further training, or in the case of students entering the workplace, the award will be placed on account on behalf of the recipient at a store which carries tools appropriate to the recipients trade.
