One scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00 and \$500.00 each will be awarded by the Laurel American Legion Auxiliary Post 19. All are gift scholarships and not loans.

RULES

1. Applicants must be:
 - a. A student who is just beginning his/her education or returning to the classroom after some period in which his/her formal education was interrupted.
2. Applicants must present the completed application to **LAUREL AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY Post 19 Unit President on OR BEFORE May 15, 2024**
3. Judging, at all levels, shall be on the following basis:

Character/Leadership	25%
Initiative/Goals	25%
Financial Need	25%
Academic Achievement	25%

The Decision of the Judges shall be final.

4. The award will be paid directly to the school for the first semester upon notification from the school that the student has registered. **The Laurel American Legion Auxiliary Post 19 must receive certification of enrollment within 12 months of a winner's notification, or the scholarship will be forfeited.** The scholarship must be used within 24 months of the date the winner receives notification, or the scholarship will be forfeited. Thus, if winning student does not wish to use monies for FIRST YEAR expenses, it must then be used the SECOND-YEAR expenses or forfeited.
