Application Check List*

Before emailing/sealing your application, please make sure all items listed below are included:

- Completed and signed scholarship application (signed by applicant and parent/guardian)
- Essay (One-page typed, narrative)
- Two typed letters of recommendations
 - i. One from school (i.e. teacher, counselor or coach) and
 - ii. One from community leader (i.e. pastor, mentor, coach or work supervisor.)
 - iii. Letters may not be written by family members or members of Sussex County Alumnae Chapter, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc.
- Official High School Transcript (with numerical value, official signature and sealed in official envelope)
- Disclaimer for scholarship funds disbursement (signed by parent/guardian)
- * Any missing items listed above will result in an incomplete package. Incomplete packages will not be considered for an award.



Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. is an international public service sorority that is comprised of over 350,000 predominately African American women. Encouraging young men and women to achieve excellence through higher education is a primary focus of our organization. We support this focus by awarding Scholarship Applications to young people who exemplify academic excellence, strong leadership, and community involvement. We are asking all guidance counselors to distribute this scholarship packet to all applicants that meet the minimum criteria (You may make copies as needed). Scholarship applications must be postmarked no later than April 29, 2024. Notification of awards will be made in May 2024.

This scholarship program is for graduating Sussex County high school seniors, only.

- Applicants must be graduating seniors who reside in Sussex County, Delaware.
- Applicants must attend an accredited college, university or post-secondary institution within one year of the award.
- Applicants must have at least a 2.75 cumulative Grade Point Average on a 4.0 scale to qualify for a scholarship award. Guidance counselors are required to submit an official high school transcript with a numerical value and official signature, by the guidance counselor, and submitted in an official sealed envelope or emailed to scholarshipscacdst@gmail.com.
- Applicants are required to submit two typed letters of recommendation (in a sealed envelope if mailed).

Applicants are required to submit a typed one-page narrative essay explaining why they are deserving of a scholarship and how the scholarship will assist them in achieving their goals.

The essay is an important part of the selection process. The essay must be double-spaced, Times New Roman 12 point font, one page maximum, with one inch margins on all sides and name typed in the upper right-hand corner of the page.

In reviewing the essays, the judges will consider the following criteria in selecting winners:

- -Creativity
- -Correct use of grammar and punctuation
- -Originality and quality of ideas presented
- -Neatness
- -Ability to adhere to presented topic
